Fee Adjustments as a Result of Act 89

Act 89, which became law on Nov. 25, 2013, amends many sections of Title 75, including adjustments to fees effective April 1, 2014. Act 89 represents an investment in Pennsylvania's future: increasing public safety, driving commerce, creating jobs and providing reliable funding for our transportation needs without leaving the bill to our future generations.

The Act amended the following sections of Title 75:

- Section 1951 adjusts the fee for photo identification cards from \$13.50 to \$27.50.
- Section 1951(d) adjusts the fee for duplicate (replacement) photo identification cards and driver's licenses from \$13.50 to \$27.50.
- Section 1952(a) adjusts the fee for a certificate of title from \$22.50 to \$50.
- Section 1952(b) adjusts the fee for a manufacturer's or dealer's notification of acquisition of a vehicle from another manufacturer or dealer for resale from \$3 to \$5 per vehicle.
- Section 1953 adjusts the fee for recording a security interest on a certificate of title from \$5 to \$23.
- Section 1955(a)(1) adjusts the fee for a copy of information relating to a driver, registration, title or security interest from \$5 to \$8.
- Section 1956(a) adjusts the fee for a certified copy of any Department record which the Department is authorized by law to furnish to the public from \$5 to \$22 for each record. The \$22 fee is in addition to the \$8 fee for the record.

Please ensure when completing applications affected by these fee adjustments, that you charge the correct fee. Failure to charge the correct fee beginning April 1, 2014, may result in the application being rejected for insufficient fees. Applications completed and submitted with fees in effect prior to April 1, 2014, will be handled by PennDOT for processing even if received after April 1, 2014.

Updated motor vehicle forms reflecting the above fee changes will be available on the PennDOT website on April 1, 2014. Beginning April 1, 2014, you must use the updated forms.
